Frederick County Parks and Recreation Secures VDOT Recreation Access Funds for Sherando Park

Frederick County Parks and Recreation has secured \$340,000 to provide an entrance and access road into Sherando Park from Warrior Drive in Stephens City. The grant dollars come from Recreation Access Program funds from the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) and will go towards developing the northwestern portion of Sherando Park along Warrior Drive.

The grant is a significant boost for FCPRD, having managed the property since the County acquired it in 1974. Currently, this area of Sherando Park is accessed via shared use paths and neighborhoods across Warrior Drive. With the entrance and access road paid for using VDOT funds, FCPRD will install a parking lot allowing visitors to park at this part of Sherando Park. FCPRD will also install an outdoor fitness gym as a compliment to the shared use path.

"This project represents the priorities of our residents in providing increased access to shared use trails, and then providing for adult fitness," said Jon Turkel, Park and Stewardship Planner for Frederick County. A 2012 community survey conducted by the department shows multi-use trails as the most desired facility and adult fitness as the most desired recreational activity. "This project directly responds to citizen input as we focus on meeting top needs."

The \$348,500 county contribution to the project will come from the Parks and Recreation development impact proffer account, an account funded by new residential development to help maintain county services facing an increasing population. "Funding for this project will affect nobody's tax rate," according to Jason Robertson, Parks and Recreation Director, "the use of proffered impact funds for this project keeps the local cost out of the general fund. Even better, by leveraging the state grant we are effectively doubling the value of the dollars we have available."

No completion date has been announced yet for the project which should begin in early 2017.





How do I apply for assistance through the PLAY Fund?

The application process is user-friendly. The primary qualifications are:

- Participant must be a Frederick County resident
- Participant must be under the age of 18
- Participant must meet the Family Income Guidelines as determined either by the free or reduced lunch program through Frederick County Public Schools or proof of annual household income.

Contact staff at 540-665-5678 for further assistance. Assistance for families depends on available funds coupled with a household maximum for a calendar year. In most instances a family that qualifies for funding through the PLAY Fund may be required to pay a percentage of the cost of the program.

- 2. Alcoholic Beverages: The possession of alcoholic beverages is prohibited on

park property. No intoxicated person shall enter or remain in the parks.

- 3. Animals and Pets: Animals must be kept under control at all times. Pets must be on leash no longer than six feet. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets. Pets are prohibited on or within 50 feet of an athletic complex or field, or playground.
- Camping: Persons shall not camp or lodge within any park.
- 5. For the enjoyment of everyone visiting the parks, please refer to full park guidelines posted in the park kiosks and on the web site at www.fcprd.net.
