Step 1: Get your family together and draw a floor plan of your home, marking all window and doors.

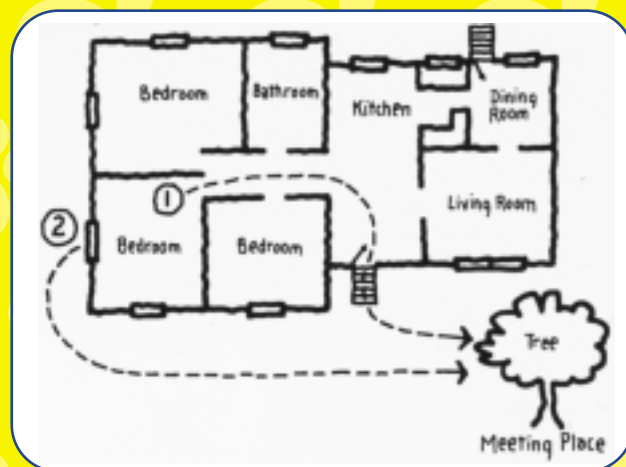
Step 2: Show two ways out of each room in case your main route is blocked by smoke or flames. Make sure windows can be opened easily.

Step 3: Agree on an outside meeting place where every family member will wait for the fire department.

Step 4: Install smoke alarms in or near every sleeping area and on each level of your home.

Step 5: Practice your plan at least twice a year.

Step 6: Once out, stay out! Don't go back inside for any reason.
