Residential Daily Supervision

Assistance with basic living skills to include the following: managing allowance money, proper spending techniques, budgeting principles, association of where money comes from and goes, proper attire, proper self-cleanliness techniques, meal preparation, structured chore schedule, proper “fun (playtime)” techniques, age-appropriate career exploration activities and a health and fitness program.

Educational / academic support services to include homework tutoring, and school lesson reinforcement, school advocacy support

Off Campus Activities to include any activity that will seek to aid the child in accepting and interacting with the community positively. Activities will include but not be limited to park recreation time, site seeing tours, museum tours, library activities, and professional sports events.

Transportation services within the local jurisdiction to the following; off-campus communal activities, doctor’s appointments, family visitations, and court appearances.

Case Management Services to include the following: documenting past social history, documenting current social behaviors, preparing monthly service plan reports, preparing and updating individual service plan (ISP).

Parent education services for parents of children who will be reunited with their family. These services will include, but will not be limited to, aiding guardians in understanding their child’s ISP, providing guardians with a proper structured day routine, teaching parents techniques to implement our “basic living skills” for their children at home, and working with parents to receive proper social services.

Services will be facilitated to stabilize the child emotionally and to facilitate the child's return to his pre-crisis psycho-social and educational functioning, while overall fostering psycho-social development so that he can function appropriately in the community. Counselors will complete session work designed around the model of community aid, safe coping, and positive peer behavioral reinforcement.
