



- FCPRD shares facilities with Frederick County Schools and must cancel programs when these facilities are not available.
- 4. Refunds will be given until a program begins to the registering household; however, a 20% administrative charge will be deducted. In the case where goods and/or services have been purchased (i.e. tickets, transportation costs, deposits, reservation charges) participants may not be given a refund. In most cases, gift certificates will be issued in lieu of a cash refund. No refunds or gift certificates will be approved after the start of a program.
- 5. Separate fees apply for withdrawal from basicREC and CAMP basicREC. Refer to the parent handbook available online at www.fcprd.net or call the main office for full details. Participants must be picked up by the program ending time. Late pick up fees apply: \$15 for the first 15 minutes

- or any portion thereof; \$2 per minute over 15 minutes.
- 6. Returned checks are assessed a \$35 NSF fee. Your account may be forwarded to the County Treasurer's Office for collection if your account is not paid in full.
- 7. FCPRD reserves the right to photograph and videotape all activities, events, classes, programs, and facilities for promotional purposes.
