

#### Workforce Draw 45-Minute Drive-Time

Frederick County draws from a skilled workforce that is nurtured at all levels. Labor supply for Frederick County is drawn from a 45-minute drive-time in Virginia, Maryland, Pennsylvania, and West Virginia. The total labor supply is more than 340,000 professionals, of which 91.6% are high school graduates and 40.4% hold an associate degree or higher.


