Basic Firearms Safety Class

Frederick County, Va-The Frederick County Sheriff's Office will provide to the public a free basic firearms safety course. The 2-hour course will cover basic operation of firearms; dismantling, cleaning, and reassembling of firearms; and federal and state laws pertaining to firearms. The firearms instructors are certified through Virginia's Department of Criminal Justice Services, so the class will meet the requirements of Virginia Code §18.2-308.02(B) for obtaining a concealed handgun permit.

The classes will be held at the Frederick County Public Safety Building at 1080 Coverstone Drive with classes limited to 25 adults per class. Pre-registration is required, and students may bring an unloaded firearm to the class. The first classes of 2020 will be held on January 13, 2020 from 6:30-8:30 p.m., January 21, 2020 from 6:30-8:30 p.m., and January 25, 2020 from 8:30-10:30 a.m.
