Winchester Regional Airport staff is in contact with local, state, and federal partners on the latest developments regarding the spread of COVID-19 and its impact to our facility. The airport remains committed to its mission of “meeting the aviation needs of the region” while responsibly ensuring the safety of its employees, customers, and community. As of this date, service levels are not reduced, and the following mitigation measures have been implemented:

- The main terminal building is restricted to based pilots, business tenants, or guests for arriving/departing aircraft.
- Public touch points (e.g., coffee, magazines) have been removed and surfaces are being routinely sanitized.
- Meetings in the terminal building conference room are cancelled until further notice.
- The VALOR 5K runway run scheduled for March 28th has been cancelled.

Additionally, the airport has an existing agreement with PHI Air Medical, operator of an air ambulance helicopter fleet, for its pilots to use airport equipment to fuel their aircraft. This allows for the continuity of their critical life-saving mission should airport staff be unavailable.

We appreciate your understanding, and will continue to provide updates on airport operations, as necessary.
