FCPRD Responds to Coronavirus Disease Threat

EFFECTIVE UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE

CLOSED/CANCELLED/POSTPONED: All Scheduled Programs and Sports Leagues, basicREC, Community Centers, Trips, and all Private Indoor/Outdoor Facility Rentals

Effective Tuesday, March 24, 2020 : Certain features at Frederick County parks, including playgrounds, pools, outdoor exercise equipment, athletic fields, shelters, paddle boats, and the Rose Hill Park restrooms will be closed to the public as part of the County's response to COVID-19. This applies to Sherando Park, Clearbrook Park, Rose Hill Park, Frederick Heights Park, Stonewall Park, and Reynold's Store. As a reminder, do not use parks or trails if you're sick or showing symptoms, practice good hygiene, and observe the CDC's minimum recommended social distancing of six feet from another person.

basicREC SUSPENDED: Due to the cancellation of the remaining FCPS School year, the basicREC school-year program has been suspended and all accounts will be closed. As soon as we are able; we will provide care options and programs for your children. Please check our website and Facebook page frequently for program announcements.

OPEN: All Parks – Restrooms are open at Sherando and Clearbrook Parks only. (Pool Restrooms are CLOSED)
