Case Management	Residential Case Management	Case management consists of maintaining records, making calls and sending emails regarding residents, compiling monthly reports, scheduling meetings, coordinating visitation, and discharge planning.	Included		NO
1:1 Supervision	Individualized Support Services	(Must be preauthorized by FAPT; if denied by Magellan) – consist of one to one supervision for residents that need or poses more severe behaviors or need closely monitored during normal awake hours	Daily	\$190	No
Residential Services	Transportation (outside of group home school district)	(Must be preauthorized by FAPT) - Provide transportation to and from school that attend a school that is not within the group home school district and transportation is not provided out of zone school district. Therapeutic Behavior Intervention	Individualized Support Services	Therapeutic services that is rendered in a residential setting that provides structure for daily activities, psycho-education, and therapeutic supervision and behavioral health treatment to ensure the attainment of therapeutic mental health goals as identified in the individual service plan. Psycho-educational activities to include: Anger Management, Social Skill development, Stress Management, Life Skills, Substance Abuse Prevention, Self Esteem Development, and Communication Skill Development.
