Participants must meet the following guidelines when considering swim team:

Youth ages 5-8 years: ability to swim 25 yards on the surface without stopping.

Youth ages 9-18 years: ability to swim 50 yards on the surface without stopping.

Swim team will not take the place of swim lessons. If you are unsure about your child's ability, register for the program and our coaches will evaluate your child. If he or she does not meet the minimum qualifications, you will receive a full refund.

Registration includes a swim cap and t-shirt.

SWIM LESSONS

FCPRD follows the guidelines of the American Red Cross Learn to Swim program. Please read the description of each class to register for the appropriate skill level. Each level is based on a skills progression and may need to be repeated until the student is comfortable enough to progress to the next level.

During swim lessons, guardians may watch their children from the grass areas. Please no parents or siblings on the pool deck during swim lesson unless the program designates parents are involved.

Following morning lessons, patrons staying to swim for the day must leave and re-enter the pool area when it opens for the day.

The registration deadline is Thursday at 11 p.m. for the following week's session of lessons. We do not encourage you to sign up for more than one week of lessons at a time, we cannot adjust for situations where advancement was not met in the previous session.

For all swim lesson levels: classes canceled due to inclement weather will be scheduled for make-ups on Friday, Saturday or Sunday during the regular time of your scheduled lesson. Please check with your instructor for exact make-up information. Classes will only be cancelled during an electrical storm, if it is only raining, the class will be held as scheduled.

The following courses are all \$40 for a one week session:

Parent and Me

Parent and Me introduces basic aquatic skills and knowledge to parents and children. Parents learn how to safely work with, encourage, prepare, and support with their child in the water. Children receive an introduction to basic skills that will lay a foundation for learning to swim.

Introduction to Swimming

This course is designed for 3-5 year olds. Interactive games and activities will be featured and are intended to encourage your child to enjoy the water. This class will help participants become more familiar and independent in the water. The focus of this class will include but is not limited too; water entry and exit, underwater skills, floating and gliding with assistance, arm and leg action, and water safety.

LEVEL I (Lv. 1)

Level 1 introduces basic aquatic skills, which participants continue to build on as they progress through Levels. In addition, participants start developing positive attitudes, effective swimming habits and safe practices in and around the water.

LEVEL II (Lv. 2)

The objective of Level 2 is to give participants success with fundamental skills. This level marks the beginning of true movement skills. Participants learn to glide and float without support and recover to a vertical position. Participants further develop simultaneous and alternating arm and leg actions on the front and back, laying the foundation for future strokes. New water safety topics are introduced, and previously acquired water safety knowledge and skills are reinforced.

LEVEL III (Lv. 3)

The objectives of Level 3 are to expand proficiency of previously learned skills by providing additional guided practice. Participants learn and practice survival floating and learn to swim front crawl and elementary backstroke at rudimentary proficiency levels. You introduce the scissors and dolphin kicks and extend the time duration for treading water. Participants also learn rules for headfirst entries and begin to learn to enter the water headfirst from a seated position at poolside (if the water is 9 feet deep or deeper). As in all levels, new and previously addressed water safety topics are included. Participants who successfully complete Level 3 have achieved basic water competency in a pool environment.

LEVEL IV (Lv. 4)

In Level 4, participants improve their aquatic skills and increase their endurance by swimming the strokes learned in Level 3 (i.e., front crawl, elementary backstroke) for greater distances and with more advanced proficiency. Participants add arm actions to the previously learned scissors kick and breaststroke kick to perform the rudimentary sidestroke and to learn the breaststroke. Participants also begin to learn the back crawl and butterfly, as well as the basics of performing a simple open turn at a wall.

Lifequarding Certification - Blended Learning

Instructor: Super Splasher Aquatics

This American Red Cross Lifeguarding course provides entry-level participants the knowledge and skills to prevent, recognize and respond to aquatic emergencies and to provide care for breathing and cardiac emergencies, injuries and sudden illnesses until EMS personnel takes over. Participants are expected to review Lifeguarding Manual prior to the first day of class. Students who successfully complete this course will receive an American Red Cross certificate for Lifequarding, First Aid, CPR and AED which is valid for 2 years.






