PAYMENT OPTIONS



GROUP SWIM LESSONS

FCPRD follows the guidelines of the American Red Cross Learn to Swim program. Each level is based on a skills progression and may need to be repeated until the student is comfortable enough to progress to the next level. **We do not encourage** you to sign up for more than one week of lessons at a time, we cannot adjust for situations where advancement was not met in the previous session. *Our entire schedule of group swimming lessons is available on the next page*.

INTRODUCTION TO SWIMMING

This course is designed for 3-5 year olds. Interactive games and activities will be featured and are intended to encourage your child to enjoy the water. This class will help participants become more familiar and independent in the water. The focus of this class will include water entry and exit, underwater skills, floating and gliding with assistance, arm and leg action, and water safety.

LEVEL 1 ☐

Level 1 introduces basic aquatic skills, which participants will continue to build on as they progress through Levels. In addition, participants start developing positive attitudes, effective swimming habits and safe practices in and around the water.

LEVEL 2 □

Participants will learn to glide and float without support and recover to a vertical position. Participants further develop simultaneous and alternating arm and leg actions on the front and back, laying the foundation for future strokes. New water safety topics are introduced, and previously acquired water safety knowledge and skills are reinforced.

STROKE DEVELOPMENT (SD)

This program helps participants improve their swimming abilities and stroke development. They will learn survival floating, front crawl, and elementary backstroke at a fundamental level. Scissors and dolphin kicks will be introduced, along with rules for headfirst entries if the water is 9 feet deep or deeper. They will continue to improve their skills and endurance by adding arm actions to previously learned kicks, learning breaststroke, back crawl, and simple open turns.




