Athlete Code of Conduct

- Respect: Treat teammates, opponents, coaches, and officials with respect at all times.
- Sportsmanship: Win or lose, show good sportsmanship. Congratulate opponents and never taunt or use foul language.
- Effort: Always give your best effort in practices and games.
- Teamwork: Support and encourage your teammates. Work together to achieve team goals.
- Honesty: Play by the rules. Do not cheat, lie, or engage in unsportsmanlike conduct.
- Safety: Follow all safety guidelines and instructions. Inform coaches of injuries or unsafe situations.
- Self-Control: Manage emotions and remain positive, even when things don't go your way.

Spectator Code of Conduct

- Positive Support: Cheer for all athletes in a positive manner. Avoid negative comments about officials, coaches, players, or other spectators.
- Respect Decisions: Accept officials' decisions without argument or criticism.
- Role Model: Set a good example for children by displaying respect, self-control, and sportsmanship.
- Sideline Behavior: Stay off the playing field and within designated spectator areas.
- Safety: Do not engage in any aggressive or disruptive behavior.
- Encouragement: Focus on effort and improvement, not just winning.

Coach Code of Conduct

- Leadership: Be a positive role model for players and spectators.
- Respect: Treat all athletes, officials, parents, and opposing coaches with respect.
- Development: Prioritize athlete development, learning, and fun over winning.
- Safety: Ensure the physical and emotional safety of all players.
- Fairness: Give all athletes opportunities to participate and develop their skills.
- Integrity: Teach and uphold the rules of the game. Do not tolerate cheating or unsportsmanlike conduct.
- Communication: Maintain open, honest, and respectful communication with players and parents.

Enforcement & Consequences
