



Alice C. Tyler Village – Service Description

Childhelp is a private psychiatric residential treatment facility located in rural Virginia, for children ages 5-14 years, grades K-8th grade.

We provide evidence based clinical interventions and therapeutic residential programming, utilizing a multidisciplinary approach for the treatment of psychiatric mental and behavioral health disorders. Services are trauma informed and directed toward meeting the child's social, emotional, spiritual, and educational needs.

We offer individual, group and family therapies, psychiatric medication management, case coordination, family engagement and nursing services. Children participate in education services through our VDOE licensed private therapeutic day school program and can continue receiving special education interventions while in residential treatment.

Our multidisciplinary team performs necessary screenings and assessments to provide treatment recommendations in preparation for discharge.

Additional services children may receive while at Childhelp include but are not limited to:

- Equine therapy,
- Occupational Assessment and Therapy,
- Speech and Language Assessment and Therapy,
- Dietary and Nutritional evaluation and intervention, as well as
- Spiritual Assessment and Intervention.

Psychological and Psychosexual testing may be requested with FAPT approval and funding.
