RESIDENTIAL

SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVICES

Daily Educational Services with no related services - \$276

Daily Educational Services with 1 - 30 minutes of related services each week - \$306 Daily Educational Services with 31 - 60 minutes of related services each week - \$336

Daily Educational Services with 61 - 90 minutes of related services each week - \$366

Daily Educational Services with 91 - 120 minutes of related services each week - \$396

Related Services are defined as Occupational or Speech Therapy and are only provided and billed when specified in the student's IEP.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES (Provided as needed)

One to One Instruction/Supervision \$40.00/hour Single Room – when requested/clinically required \$400/day Ancillary Therapies/MD Charges* \$53.50/day CSOTP Therapy \$120.00/hour

Psychological Testing as requested \$1500-2200 (depending on extent of testing)

Transportation** \$45.00/hour per staff, plus lodging (when necessary)

*These rates are subject to change in accordance with Virginia Medicaid's Rate setting procedure as per the contract. Liberty Point based these rates upon DMAS notification of new rates effective 7/1/2024. DMAS requires ancillary therapy and physician services, billable and excluded from daily rates above.

**Liberty Point will not charge for transports within a 10-mile radius of the facility for required medical treatment scheduled by the facility.

Please note, reimbursement for treatment services will be utilized first by Medicaid. If Medicaid funding is not available, the CSA/CPMT will be responsible. CSA is responsible for informing Liberty Point of all known forms of insurance coverage and IV-E status for each youth prior to the date of admission. CSA is responsible for upheld denial balances from alternative sources when/if not disclosed.
