Public notice is hereby given that the Board of Equalization for the County of Frederick will meet on the days hereafter listed for the purpose of hearing and recording complaints of inequalities including errors in acreage pertaining to the 2015 general reassessment of all real property. Upon hearing such complaints, either oral or written, the BOE will give consideration AND EITHER INCREASE, DECREASE, OR AFFIRM such real estate assessments. Before a change can be granted, the taxpayer or legal agent must overcome a clear presumption in favor of the assessment by proving that the property is not uniform or equitable with other similar properties, the assessment has an error in fact, or the property is assessed in excess of its fair market value. Taxpayers must, by law, bring or attach supporting documentation of their claim at the time of their hearing or written appeal.

Appointments are required to attend a hearing and will be scheduled every 10 minutes to minimize waiting. Please call 540.722.8319 (ask for "Reassessment") between 9 am and 4 pm, from Monday, April 6, 2015 through Friday, May 8, 2015 to schedule an appearance before the BOE. Hearings will be held in the Frederick County Administration Building at 107 North Kent Street, 1st Floor.
