



About Constitutional Officers

- Thomas Jefferson believed deeply that government works best when it is close to the people and ultimately responsible to them through the ballot box. In Virginia, the public elects not just its local, state, and federal representatives, but also its constitutional officers, so named because the constitutional offices are specifically established by the Constitution of Virginia.
- Constitutional Officers:
 - Clerk of the Circuit Court
 - Commissioner of the Revenue
 - Commonwealth Attorney
 - Sheriff
 - Treasurer

About Constitutional Officers, cont.

- The mission of the Compensation Board is to determine a fair and reasonable budget for the participation of the Commonwealth towards the cost of office operations for constitutional officers and their staff.
- Budget Process – The General Assembly determines the total amount of funds and positions available to each group of constitutional officers.
- Funding – 95% of the Compensation Board's annual appropriation is for staff salaries. Workloads are based on staffing standards to determine the # of positions that each office is due. These staffing standards are used to allocate new positions. Keep in mind that positions that are “due” to an office are not necessarily funded.

Issues Facing Frederick County in FY 2015:

- Affordable Care Act
- Health Care Increased Costs
- Changes to VRS
- Implementing Five Year Capital Replacement Plan
- Salary survey study by independent consultant
- FY 2014 items funded in the Fall that will affect FY 2015
- Not included in FY 2015 Budget: Outcome of the Right Sizing Study – Positions (other than PIO) not included in budget.
 - Need directive → How to Proceed → Two Options
 - Option 1: Estimate and include in FY 2015 Budget
 - Option 2: Supplemental Appropriation presented to Finance Committee

VRS

- Employees now have three plans
 - Prior to July 1, 2010 ➔ Plan 1
 - July 1, 2010 – December 31, 2013 ➔ Plan 2
 - January 1, 2014 ➔ Hybrid Plan
- Complicated for staff to administer and employees to understand.
- Current VRS rate:

The VRS Board sets the County rate, unlike the Schools which is set by the General Assembly.

Scenario Presentation

- Question: What do you want presented in the Scenarios?
 - A. What assumptions should be presented? (tax rate, fund balance funding)
 - B. What level of detail is desired?
- Note: Ratio of 43/57 split with Schools will not include all General Fund increases, but rather the increase in local tax dollars only.
 - Why: Other revenues in the General Fund are program driven.
 - Examples:
 - Fire and Rescue revenue recovery
 - Grants
 - Compensation Board funding
 - Fire Programs

A budget is a plan of financial activity for a fiscal year indicating all planned revenues and expenses for the budget period. The Finance Department coordinates and prepares the county budget. The budget is submitted to the Board of Supervisors by the County Administrator. In order to produce a fiscally sound budget, the department analyses activities of the current and past years, researches trends in both revenues and expenditure categories and provides financial management and research assistance. The objective during the budget process is to help the Board of Supervisors and management make informed choices about the provision of services and capital assets, and to promote citizen participation in the process. The County operates on a fiscal year that is from July 1st to June 30th.
