On 10/17/2014 Frederick County Emergency Communications received a BOL from Montgomery County, Tennessee in reference to a vehicle containing an individual wanted out of their jurisdiction. At 0908 hours deputies spotted the vehicle on Rt. 37 at Cedar Creek Grade. Upon stopping the vehicle the suspect was located in said vehicle. He was removed from vehicle and placed in one of the Frederick County Sheriff's Office cruisers. Suspect was handcuffed behind the back. Once the officer placed him in a cruiser, he proceeded to help deputies with the other occupants. A short time later the police cruiser, the suspect was in, was seen being driven away by the suspect. Another deputy got in pursuit southbound on Rt. 37. After a short pursuit the vehicle was stopped with assistance from Virginia State Police at Valley Pike and Rt. 37 entrance to Kernstown Commons. Suspect was removed from the stolen cruiser and transported to Winchester Medical Center with non-life threatening injuries. During the pursuit the vehicle was driven above the posted speed limit, and in a reckless manor. Virginia State Police is working the accident. Suspect is a juvenile and wanted out of Tennessee in reference to a shooting, burglary, and escape. At this time Frederick County deputies will be seeking petitions related to today's incident.
