INMATE ACCOUNTS & CANTEEN SERVICE

The Inmate Commissary sells a wide variety of goods. In order for an inmate to participate in the commissary service, he or she must be eligible and have sufficient funds in his/her account in order to submit a purchase request. The Commissary prices are consistent with the local market.

A 24 hour cash Kiosk is located in the Main Jail lobby for monetary deposits to an inmate's account. Money orders may be sent to an inmate through the mail. Money orders must be clearly written and contain the receiving inmate's name and the sender's name and address. Checks are not accepted.

Funds deposited to an inmate's account will allow an inmate to order commissary items, permit telephone calls, pay medical co-pay and housing fees.

INMATE RELEASE CHECK

Inmates released from Jail who have a positive account balance are entitled to the funds remaining in their account. "Inmate Release Checks" are available for pick up at the Main Jail lobby Monday through Friday from 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. excluding holidays.

TELEPHONE SERVICE

Inmates are not permitted personal incoming telephone calls. Emergency messages will be given to inmates after they have been confirmed as legitimate.

Inmate telephones are available between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 10:30 p.m. for outgoing calls to any location. Inmate calls can be made collect or billed to their canteen account. There is no limit on the number of calls an inmate can make.

Collect call billing inquiries may be made to Global Tel-Link by calling 1-800-483-8413. Requests to place a block on your service to prevent an unwanted call should be made to your local carrier and Global Tel-Link.

You may send an unlimited number of letters through the United States Postal Service. Only standard legal (10"x13") or letter (8.5" x 11") correspondence will be accepted. Greeting cards or other card style mail will not be accepted. Mail should be addressed using the inmate's First and Last name, 141 Fort Collier Road, Winchester VA 22603 for the Main Facility or 147 Fort Collier Road, Winchester VA 22603 for the Community Corrections Center. Sender must put full return address in upper left corner, including their first and last name. Failure to properly address mail or putting, additional markings/drawings on the envelope, will result in mail being returned to sender.

Inmate mail is inspected for contraband. Newspapers are accepted when mailed directly from their publisher. Personal magazines and books are not permitted.

TRANSPORTATION

If you need transportation to the Regional Jail, there are several transportation systems available that stop directly in front of the facility or within walking distance.
