Fall Shred Fest: Saturday, September 26

Frederick County Recycling will hold a free community shred event on Saturday, September 26. Fall Shred Fest will be held from 8 a.m. to noon at the corner of Martinsburg Pike and Stine Lane in the Shockey Companies parking lot.

Shred Fest is a free opportunity to protect one's identity by safely destroying old personal paper documents such as old tax records, bank statements and checks, bill stubs and even junk mail containing personal information, according to Frederick County's Solid Waste Manager, Gloria Puffinburger. "Once destroyed by the shredder truck, the resulting bits of paper will be recycled into tissue paper."

Records Management Solutions, Inc. will offer free on-site document destruction to residents via its mobile shredding unit. Residents may bring five boxes of any size for destruction at no cost. Additional boxes will be shredded for 10 cents per pound. The business rate will be a flat fee of 10 cents per pound. There is no need to remove folders, staples, paper clips or rubber bands. All destruction activities will be open for live surveillance and Certificates of Destruction provided upon request.
